

Each student will be required to provide/complete:

❖ **Student Information and Confidentiality Agreement**

Pre-requisite Training for Observation students completing 20 plus hours (to be completed annually)

❖ **Proof of completion of the Meritus Health mandatory on-line in services**

- All in-services must be completed annually

Health and Immunization Requirements:

❖ **Tuberculosis testing as described below:**

- If the student has no PPD test with in the past year, the student will be required to obtain a 2-Step PPD test* as described below:

***What constitutes a 2-step PPD (TST)?**

The Center for Disease Control and Prevention recommends the first test be administered and then evaluated (read) 48-72 hours later, no earlier and no later. A *minimum* of 7 days and *maximum* of 21 days after the *read* of the first test, the second test can be administered. The second test is evaluated 48-72 hours later.

- If a negative PPD test result has been performed with in the past year, one additional PPD test will be required (6 months prior of student's start date).
- PPD positive individuals must submit written results of a chest x-ray (chest x-ray must be within six months prior to the start of rotation) obtained after PPD conversation
- QuantiFERON Gold blood test will be accepted as long as the student has obtained the testing within 6 months prior to start date.
- If clinical rotations within Meritus last longer than one year, the student must obtain an annual tuberculosis test.

❖ **Evidence of immunity to Hepatitis B**

- Must provide documentation of 3 Hepatitis B vaccines OR positive Hepatitis B titer

❖ **Evidence of Tdap vaccine**

- Proof of one Tdap vaccine within the last 10 years. Td is acceptable as proof if at least one Tdap has been given previously

❖ **Laboratory evidence of measles, mumps and rubella immunity OR documentation of receipt of two doses of MMR vaccine after the first birthday.**

❖ **Evidence of immunity to varicella-zoster**

- Must provide documentation of 2 varicella vaccines OR positive varicella titer

❖ **Documentation of influenza vaccine for the current year**

- Proof of current vaccination is required for anyone participating in a learning experience at Meritus Health
