The mission of Meritus Medical Center Auxiliary volunteers is to:

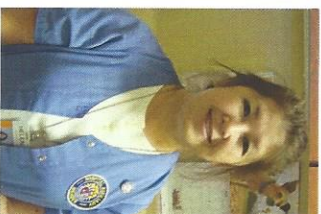
- Supplement and assist hospital staff

Volunteer opportunities for teens

There are opportunities for teens, ages 14-18, who are high school students maintaining at least a 2.0 GPA with good recommendations from their guidance counselors. Teens may earn SSL credit if willing to complete a requirement for a minimum volunteer number of hours for the auxiliary. Teens must be willing to volunteer throughout the school year. There is no available, summer-only program.



Teens ages 14 and 15 may volunteer in the coffee shop or gift shop. Teens age 16 may volunteer in nursing unit support. Teens ages 17 and 18 may volunteer in



the emergency department. All teen volunteer positions have limited availability.
