1. Plan special events for the month.

7. Send a letter of appreciation about your pastor to the local newspaper.
8. Produce a video that features highlights of your pastor’s ministry and tributes from church members, family, and friends.
9. Give a gift. Consider a plaque, flowers, balloons, scrapbook, gift certificates to a restaurant or store, a love offering, tickets to a special event, or an all-expense paid vacation.
10. Establish a scholarship fund or make a charitable donation in your pastor’s honor.
